

# Translational Research Award to unravel unexplained chronic pain in adults: etiology and potential therapeutic targets

FibroRes vzw attributes an award of € 10 000 to translational research in chronic pain in adults.

## The Translational Award guiding principles are the following:

- Candidates are scientists contributing to the research in rheumatology.
- The project must be a translational project in the field of chronic pain.
- The award must be used for a specific activity in the therapeutic domain of unexplained chronic pain (excluding studies on cannabinoids and psychological oriented studies). More specifically focusing on laboratory studies unraveling the (molecular) mechanisms and etiology and/or exploration of novel therapeutic targets.
- The presented project must be sent by e-mail to the President of the Scientific Committee of the Fund for Scientific Research in Rheumatology, Professor Rik Lories ([rik.Lories@uz.kuleuven.be](mailto:rik.Lories@uz.kuleuven.be)) and to [contact@r-euma.be](mailto:contact@r-euma.be) before November 1<sup>st</sup> 2021.
